How do I start?

- 1 You need to be a current BSAC member and a BSAC branch member.
- 2 Attend a 2-day Instructor Foundation Course (IFC): www.bsac.com/ifc
(The course will provide the 'Diving Instructor Manual' and the Instructor Resources CD-ROM)
- 3 After attending the IFC, return this form with payment and we will supply:
 - Induction Pack with reference material
 - Certification for OWI
 - Qualification card
